Our Hopes For The New Year

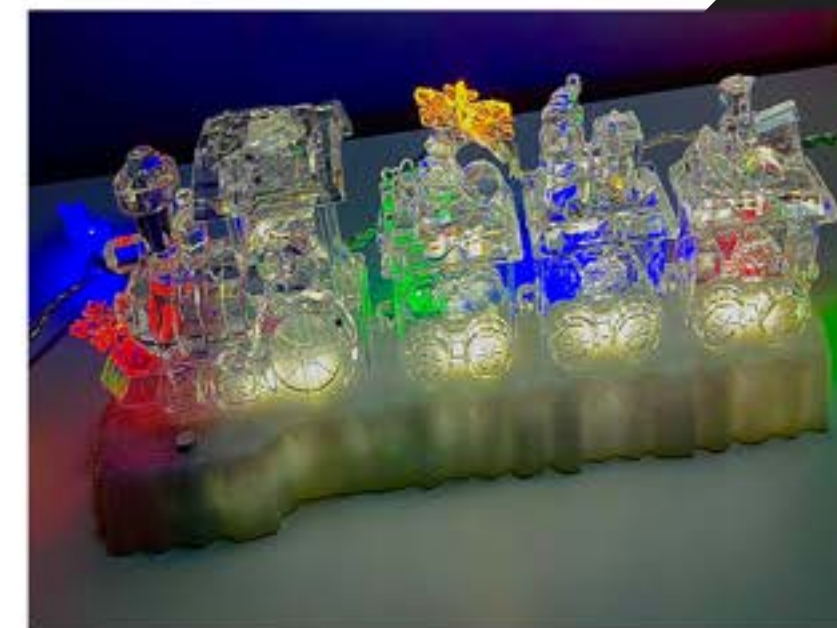
